

Tuition Assistance Information

Tuition assistance is a need-based assistance program overseen by the board-appointed Tuition Assistance Committee (TAC).

- Funding is through the budget and generous donations from current families and alumni.
- CHRISTIAN uses FACTS Grant & Aid Management to provide financial analysis and recommendations to the TAC regarding awards.
- Families needing assistance must apply online with FACTS Grant & Aid <a href=here and provide the required supporting documentation to be considered for assistance.
- The cost to apply for tuition assistance is \$40 payable to FACTS Grant & Aid when the application is submitted.
- Tuition assistance priority deadline is March 15. After March 15, tuition assistance is considered on a rolling basis.
- Tuition assistance is only available for grades 1-12.
- ◆ Awards will be communicated within 4 6 weeks after application is submitted.
- Awards are for one year only and families must reapply every year to receive assistance.
- Families who are not awarded assistance or feel that their assistance is not enough may appeal
 the decision through an email to the TAC at tuitionassistance@cdspk12.com. Please provide
 detailed information as to why additional assistance is needed.
- Families who experience a financial hardship during the school year may send a request letter with an explanation to the TAC.
